How are you assessed and how regularly?

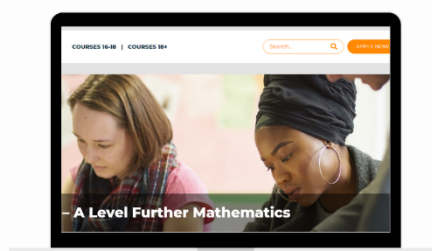
We are assessed through a mix of small, regular topic test and bigger, less frequent mock exams and past papers.
