Year 1

Year 1- Portfolio of practical work

Year 2- Two units:

- Component 1 (60%) - Personal investigation (1,300 word written study)
- Component 2 (40%) Practical coursework including a timed 15 hour practical exam

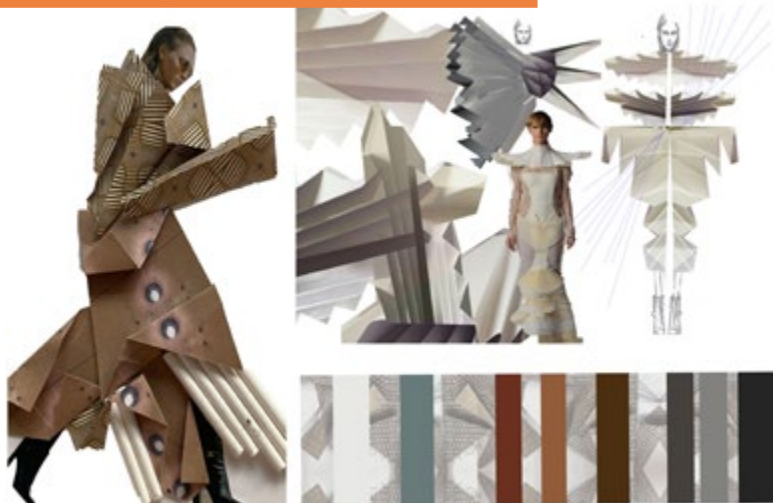

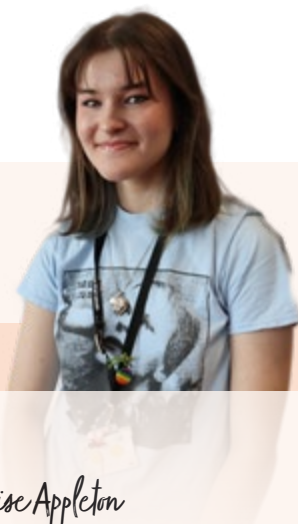
