ASSESSMENT

Component 1: Personal Investigation (60% of A Level grade)

This is a practical investigation supported by an extended essay. You will produce personal work based on an idea, issue, concept or theme.

Component 2: Externally Set Assignment (40% of A Level grade)

You will produce practical work in response to one of eight starting points on the AQA exam paper. Following the preparatory period, you will have 15 hours of supervised time to create a refined outcome.
