- Socio-cultural Studies: Sport and society / contemporary issues in sport
- Performance: A practical assessment of your skills as a performer or coach
- Evaluation and Analysis of Performance for Improvement: A verbal assessment in your chosen sport

Opportunities to take part in competitive sports teams and national competitions as well as access to high level coaching.



#### **ENRICHMENT**

- Trips and visits to extend knowledge and experience of sport including visits to Finch Farm, the National Football Museum, university visits, and more.

#### **ASSESSMENT**
