Philosophy of Religion:

This part of the course focuses on the study of Ancient Greek philosophers, Plato and Aristotle, arguments for the existence of God, challenges to religious belief, and claims to religious experience.

Ethics:

Focuses on questions relating to moral decisionmaking, the nature of ethical language, and applied issues including euthanasia and business ethics.

Christianity:

Covers issues such as the existence of God, death and afterlife, gender and theology, and the challenge of secularism.
