All resources are catalogued and fully discoverable through our 'Heritage' software which can be accessed online.

Print Collection

- Over 9,000 items including textbooks, revision materials and wider reading for all subjects
- Catalogued and fully discoverable through our Heritage software system
- Recommended reading items for prestigious universities
- Well-being books to help support you through your studies
- Study support materials for revision techniques, time management and preparing for exams
- Items are shelved in subject groups to make searching easier.

Online Resources

- Unlimited access to over 2,000 e-books
- Discoverable through our library catalogue and easily accessed by clicking 'read me'
- Additional e-resources include e-journals, databases, archives and much more.

IT Facilities and Study Spaces

- Over 70 computers
- Full wi-fi coverage that supports 'bring your own device'
- Study spaces including study carrels, single desks, computer spaces and a group work table
- Bookable spaces and walk-in spaces to cater for different learning styles
- Two multi-function printers (Printing and photocopying incurs a small charge).

Borrowing and Renewing Resources

- Access to your library account will be created on enrolment day
- You can take out 4 items at a time
- Present your student ID at the library desk to add items to your account
- Return dates will be stamped inside the item
- Items can be renewed in person, or via phone /email
- You can reserve items if they are currently out on loan to another student. You will be notified when the item is returned and ready for you to collect.
- A 'Click and Collect' service is available for reserved items. Collection from the library desk the following day.
