## GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS (Level 3 Programmes)

The general entry requirements to study a Level 3 Programme at Carmel College are as follows:-
A Level Study Programme: $5 \times$ grade 5 s or above at GCSE or equivalent
BTEC Study Programme: $5 \times$ grade 4 s or above at GCSE or equivalent
T Level Programme: $2 \times$ grade 5 s and $3 \times$ grade 4 s or above at GCSE or equivalent
Specific entry requirements for your chosen programme of study will be discussed at your guidance interview and on enrolment day.
